A Classic Jersey Tomato Re-invented 'Rutgers 250' Tomato

- An improved version of the 'Rutgers' tomato that was released in 1934, made by crossing the same parent varieties as the original.
 - Named in honor of the University's 250th anniversary.
- Mid-season maturity. Firm, crack-resistant fruit; high flavor, uniform color. Semi-determinate plants; best if staked.
